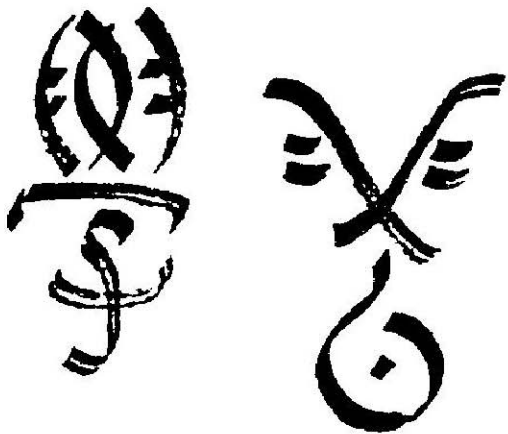

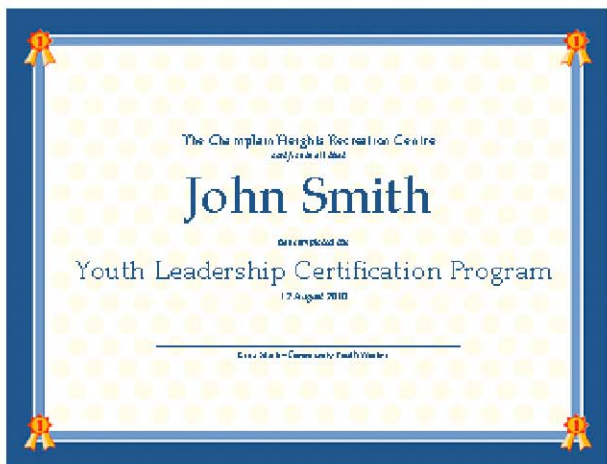

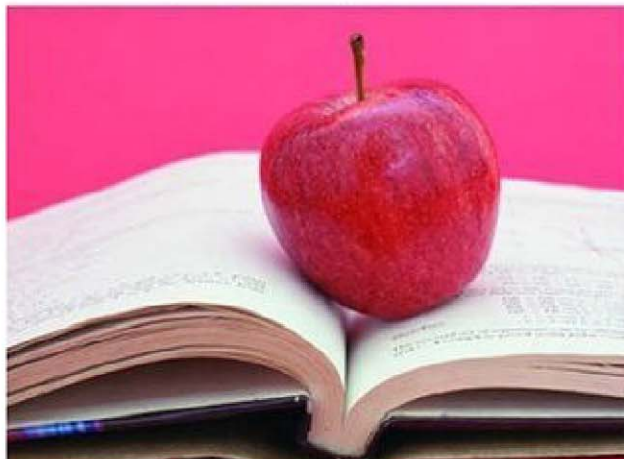


How The Program Works
