Pool Family/Accessible Change-room And Front Entrance Renovation

Renfrew Pool is closed for the long-awaited pool change room renovations. The new ones will include change areas for families, for those in wheelchairs as well as separate accessible ones for men and women, and a new pool guard area. The pool office will be rebuilt across the hallway as well as a larger, more accessible main entranceway. The old boiler and hot water tanks have been replaced by new, more efficient ones with less green house gas emissions.

During construction, there will be no access to the centre through the upper main doors - only through one of the two lower floor entrances. Access to rooms 108, 110, 112 and gymnasium will be available via the elevator or stairwell. There is a parking lot on Renfrew Street (between 20th & 21st Avenue). **Fitness Centre patrons will enter via back door of Fitness Centre. Look for signs.** Although having the pool closed again is unfortunate, we're all looking forward to these badly needed renovations.

Renovations of the new pool office, accessible changerooms as well as the entranceway to Renfrew Park Community Centre and Pool are still underway. The Park Board Planning Department and Parkwood Construction appreciate your patience throughout this process. We all look forward to enjoying the new amenities. We hope to open in early Spring.
