VANCOUVER PARKS GOLF begins growing trials with TerraBioGen organic products

Vancouver, B.C., August 9, 2011 – Vancouver Parks Golf is pleased to be working with TerraBioGen Technologies and has begun organic fertilizer trials at Langara Golf Course in Vancouver. The trial coincides with proposed legislation before the provincial government that would ban the use of cosmetic pesticides in British Columbia. A study conducted at Cornell University's Department of Horticulture demonstrated that the use of TerraBioGen's products allowed up to a 50% reduction in synthetic fertilizer applications and up to a 75% reduction in pesticides without impacting turf quality. Highly successful commercial field trials have also been conducted at Nicklaus North Golf Course in Whistler, B.C.

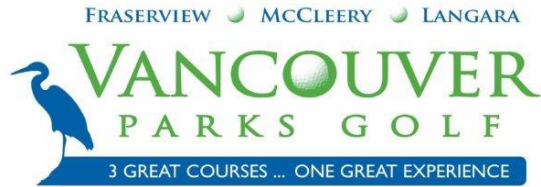
The TerraBioGen organic product will be added to the regular maintenance practices on two greens at Langara Golf Course. The product is made from locally composted food waste. Golf Course Superintendent Jeff MacLean will be measuring disease pressure differences between the treated and non-treated greens and will also be actively documenting fertility levels to see if the product has any visual effect on plant health and fertilizer requirements. He said "with the all but imminent pesticide bans or restrictions coming our way, we are trying to be as proactive as we can when it comes to finding alternate ways to deal with disease pressures."

Supervisor of Golf Operations, Howard Normann is happy to be involved in the trials. "The City of Vancouver, The Park Board and our golf courses are committed to using 'greener' and more sustainable products. An effective and affordable organic turf product will be a benefit to us, our city and the golf industry".

One application of the TerraBioGen organic product has been used thus far. The trial will continue into the fall and winter months.
