



Get Your Dog a City Licence

Animal Control By-Law No. 9150 Section 3.1

In Vancouver, all dogs older than three months must have a dog licence.

Fine for having no dog licence is \$250.

Animal Control By-law 9150 Section 3.1

All dogs older than three months must have a dog licence. Licence fees are \$37 per year for neutered and spayed animals (proof is required when you first sign up), and \$70 per year for animals that have not been fixed. Fees are due at different times of the year for each neighbourhood.

The fine for having no dog licence is \$250.

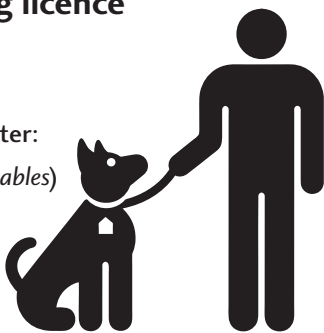
