ANNUAL PERMITS - ELECTRICAL BY-LAW #5563

- 5.12 Notwithstanding Section 5.8 the City Electrician may issue a permit described as an "Annual Permit" which shall be valid for 12 calendar months from the date issuance.
- 5.13 Where an Annual Permit has been issued to a person pursuant to this By-law, that person shall not be required during the term of such permit to obtain a permit for minor electrical work which do not increase the total connected load specified in the application by more than 5%.
- 5.14 In addition to the particulars required in Section 5.4 an application for an Annual Permit shall include the following particulars:
- a) the total existing connected load in horsepower for the premises.
 - b) the number of full-time electricians (if any) employed by the owner to service the premises.
- 5.15 No Annual Permit shall be issued to any person unless the City Electrician is satisfied that:
- a) the premises described in the application are used for industrial or commercial purposes.
 - b) either a full-time electrician or an approved electrical contractor is employed by the owner of the premises to carry out the work for which the Annual permit is to be issued.
 - c) the nature of the business carried on or to be carried on in the premises necessitates the installation, construction, alteration or repair of electrical equipment before a regular permit can be applied for issued pursuant to this By-law.
