

8 Transit

- A quality public transit system is essential to providing residents with an attractive alternative to the automobile.
- Introduction of new services at East Fraserlands will also improve transit for residents of West Fraserlands.

Summary of Proposals

- A Transit Focal Point located at the 'Town Square' will provide comfortable waiting facilities, in addition to bus stops located along the routes within the site.
- All East Fraserlands residents will be within a 5 minute walk of a bus stop and a 10 minute walk of the Transit Focal Point.
- Land is reserved next to the 'Town Square' to take advantage of the potential future use of the CPR rail corridor as a transit route, connecting to the Canada Line at Marine Drive Station and Skytrain at New Westminster.
- Translink have indicated that the following bus routes could be extended to serve the development:
 - #26 linking to Champlain Heights and Skytrain (29th Avenue and Joyce stations).
 - #29 linking to West Fraserlands, Fraserview and Skytrain (29th Avenue station).
 - #100 linking to New Westminster; and Downtown, Richmond and the Airport via the Canada Line (Marine Drive station).
 - #116 linking to Burnaby Business Park and Metrotown.
- Pier and dock structures provided at the 'Waterfront Plaza' could be adapted for use by future ferry services.
