

*** Apartment Security Tips ***

- ❖ Immediately report suspicious activity to the Police & building manager. If crime is in progress dial 9-1-1. Use non-emergency 604-717-3321 for all other calls. Suspicious activity may include:
 - Someone knocking on your suite or patio door to determine if anyone is home.
 - If the person is unknown, ask them to leave. Immediately phone the building manager and Police to advise of the incident and provide description.
 - If you encounter someone in the hallway or parking lot that appears out of place, again contact building manager and Police immediately.
- ❖ Always ensure your windows and patio doors are securely locked before leaving. Always lock your doors and windows while sleeping or bathing.
- ❖ Use tension bars for patio doors and tight fitting sticks in sliding window frames to protect against forced entries.
- ❖ When out, leave a radio or television on and put interior lights on timers.
- ❖ Use sheers or blinds to prevent someone looking easily into your unit.
- ❖ Do not allow strangers into the building. Direct any delivery or service persons to the building manager.

By working together and being observant,
