

NOISE CONTROL BYLAW 6555

Information Notice on Waste Haulers

[What is noise from refuse collection?](#)

Any noise that emanate from a motor vehicle while the vehicle is being used to collect refuse by means of *a mechanical or hydraulic lift* from a *bulk refuse container*.

[When are you allowed to collect refuse?](#)

Outside the downtown area:

Monday to Friday: 7:00am to 8:00pm
Saturday, Sunday or Holiday: 10:00am to 8:00pm

Inside the downtown area - see map (Schedule C):

Monday to Friday: 6:00am to 12:00 midnight
Saturday, Sunday or Holiday: 10:00am to 12:00 midnight

[What is defined as a holiday?](#)

A 'holiday' includes

- (a) Sunday, Christmas Day, Good Friday and Easter Monday,
- (b) Canada Day, Victoria Day, British Columbia Day, Labour Day, Remembrance Day and New Year's Day,
- (c) December 26, and
- (d) a day set by the Parliament of Canada or by the Legislature, or appointed by proclamation of the Governor General or the Lieutenant Governor, to be observed as a day of general prayer or mourning, a day of public rejoicing or thanksgiving, a day for celebrating the birthday of the reigning Sovereign, or a

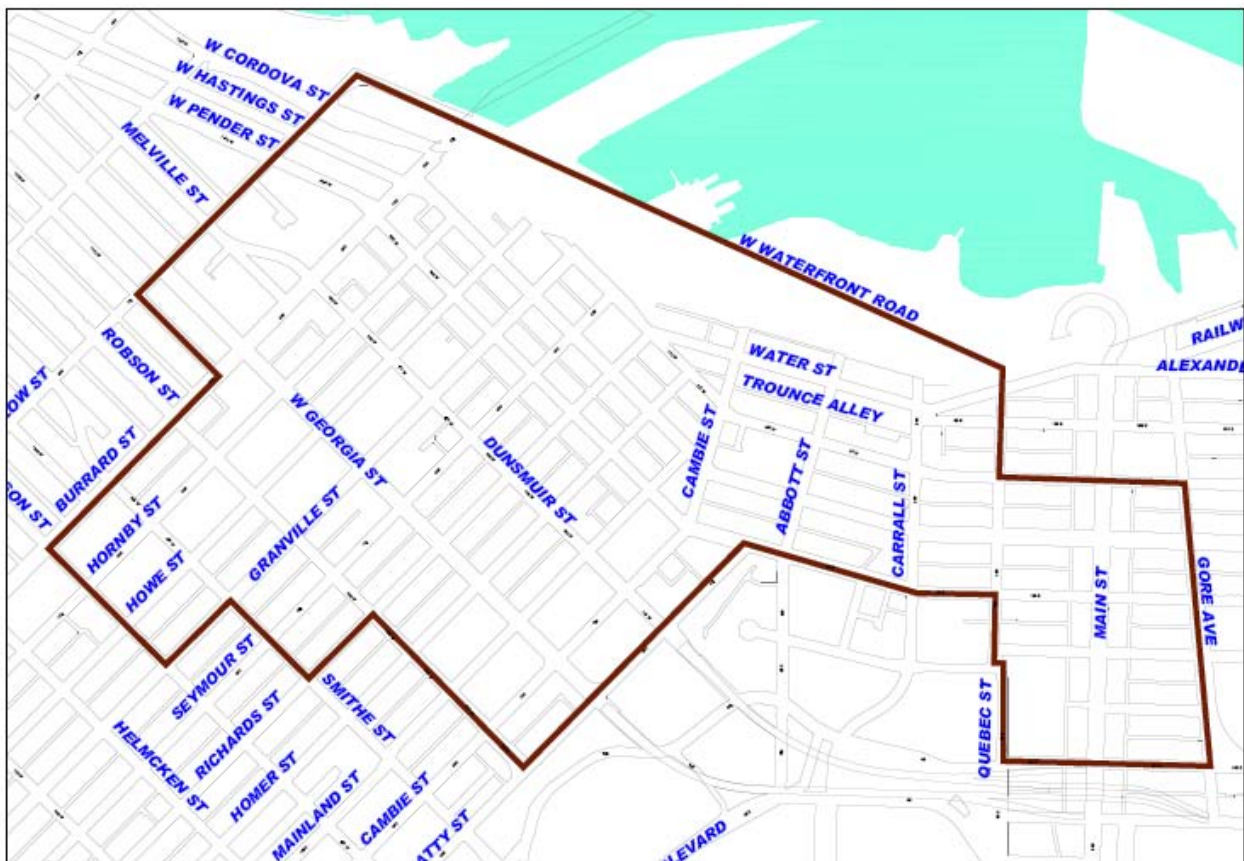
What will happen if you don't comply with the By-law?

City staff will investigate all complaints. If there is a contravention of the by-law, enforcement action will be initiated. This could result in fines, or a review of your business license.
