Surface is a live documentary of the rich underwater life of False Creek, transmitted from a camera mounted under the Aquabus (a small commuter ferry) to screens located onshore. During the term of its installation, Vancouver artist Fiona Bowie hopes to track the health of False Creek's marine life as evidence of our collective footprint.
