Riley Park/South Cambie **RPSC**

Riley Park-South Cambie (RPSC) is served by a number of bus routes. Transit service to RPSC is generally routed along the major streets. Major destinations such as the downtown core and UBC are served by many of these routes. There are also suburban services and limited stop services which are located along Oak Street and 41st Avenue.

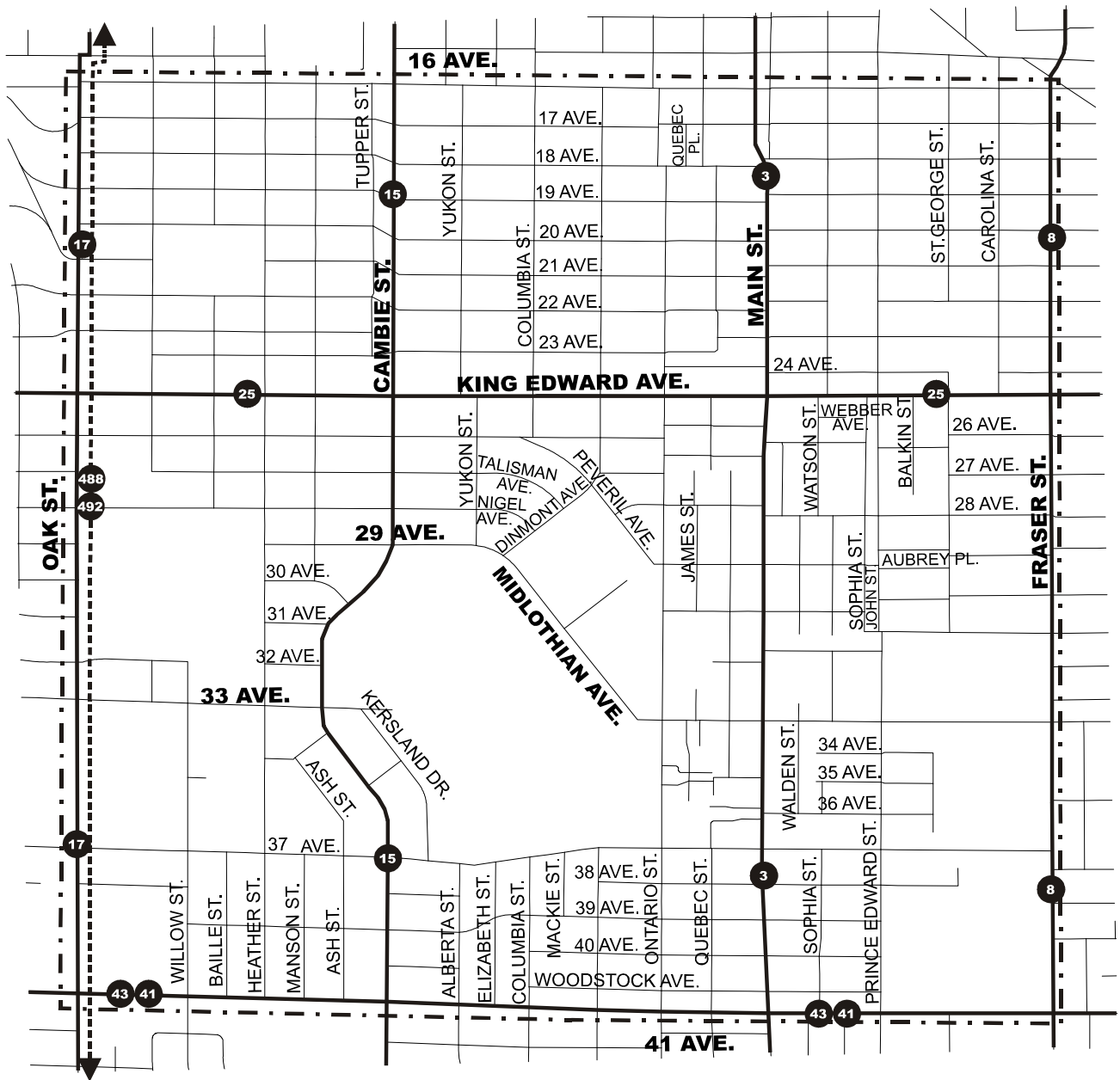
The daily boarding figures shown below are for the full route, estimated from Fall 2003 ridership. Since the implementation of the U-Pass to UBC, ridership has grown significantly.

RPSC also has transit service to Richmond. The suburban routes provide only limited stop service to Vancouver.
