#### Highlights

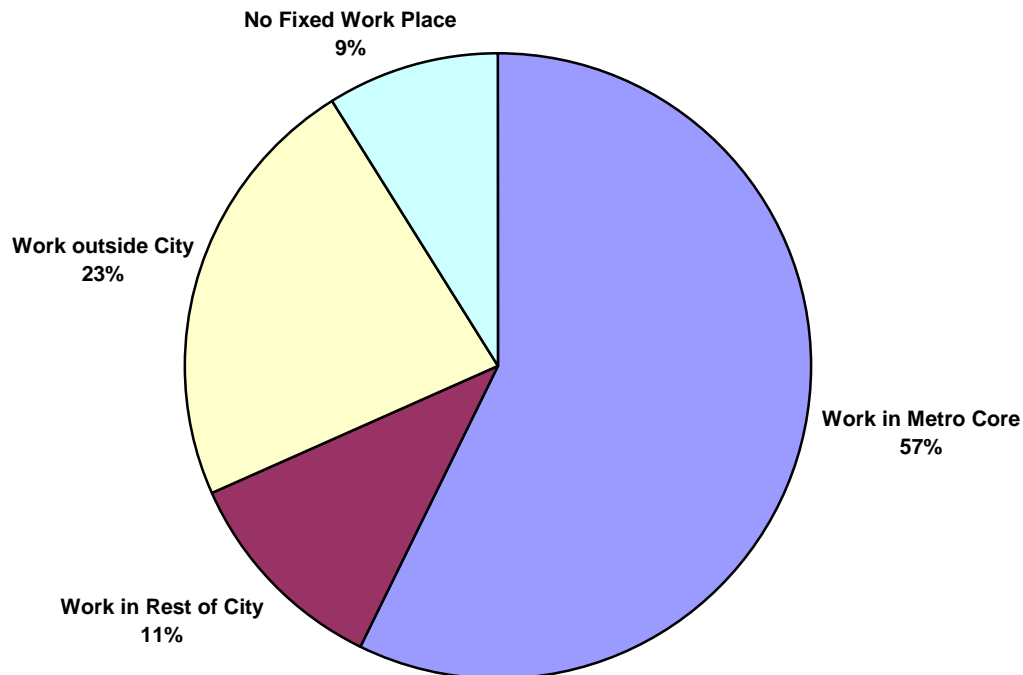
- There are 78,355 employed residents in the Metro Core.
- 68% of these residents work in Vancouver.
- 57% work in the Metro Core.
- Outside of Vancouver, other areas that provide jobs for Metro Core residents include: Burnaby/New West (7%); Richmond (5%); and North Shore (3%).



#### Where do Metro Core residents work?

The majority (68%) of employed Metro Core residents work in Vancouver, with 57% working in the Metro Core. Outside of Vancouver, other areas that provide jobs for Metro Core residents include: Burnaby/New West (7%) and Richmond (5%) (Figure 1 and Tables 1 and 2).

How does this compare to the city as a whole?

As shown in Table 1 above, 68% of employed Metro Core residents work in the city. This is higher than in the city as a whole where 63% of employed residents stay in the city to work.

Note: In the "Population, Jobs and Travel to Work Info Sheet", the number of employed Vancouver residents who stay in the City to work is estimated at 69%. This estimate is higher because it includes an allocation of Vancouver residents who report no-fixed place of work. (These residents are kept separate in Table 1 above).
