- The highest rate of part-time work is in the accommodation and food sector.



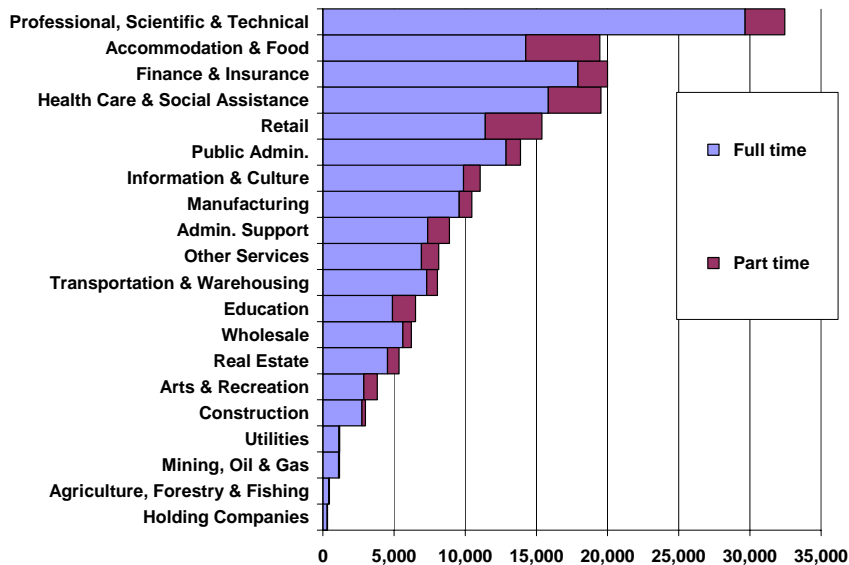
HOW MANY METRO CORE JOBS ARE PART-TIME?

There are about 28,750 part-time jobs in the Metro Core - this is 15% of all jobs where full-time and part-time status is known.

HOW DOES THE RATE OF PART-TIME WORK VARY ACROSS ECONOMIC SECTORS?

The percent of Metro Core jobs that are part-time varies considerably across economic sectors. The highest rate of part-time work is in the accommodation and food sector (Figure 1).
