TRANSPORTATION FACILITIES AND NETWORKS:

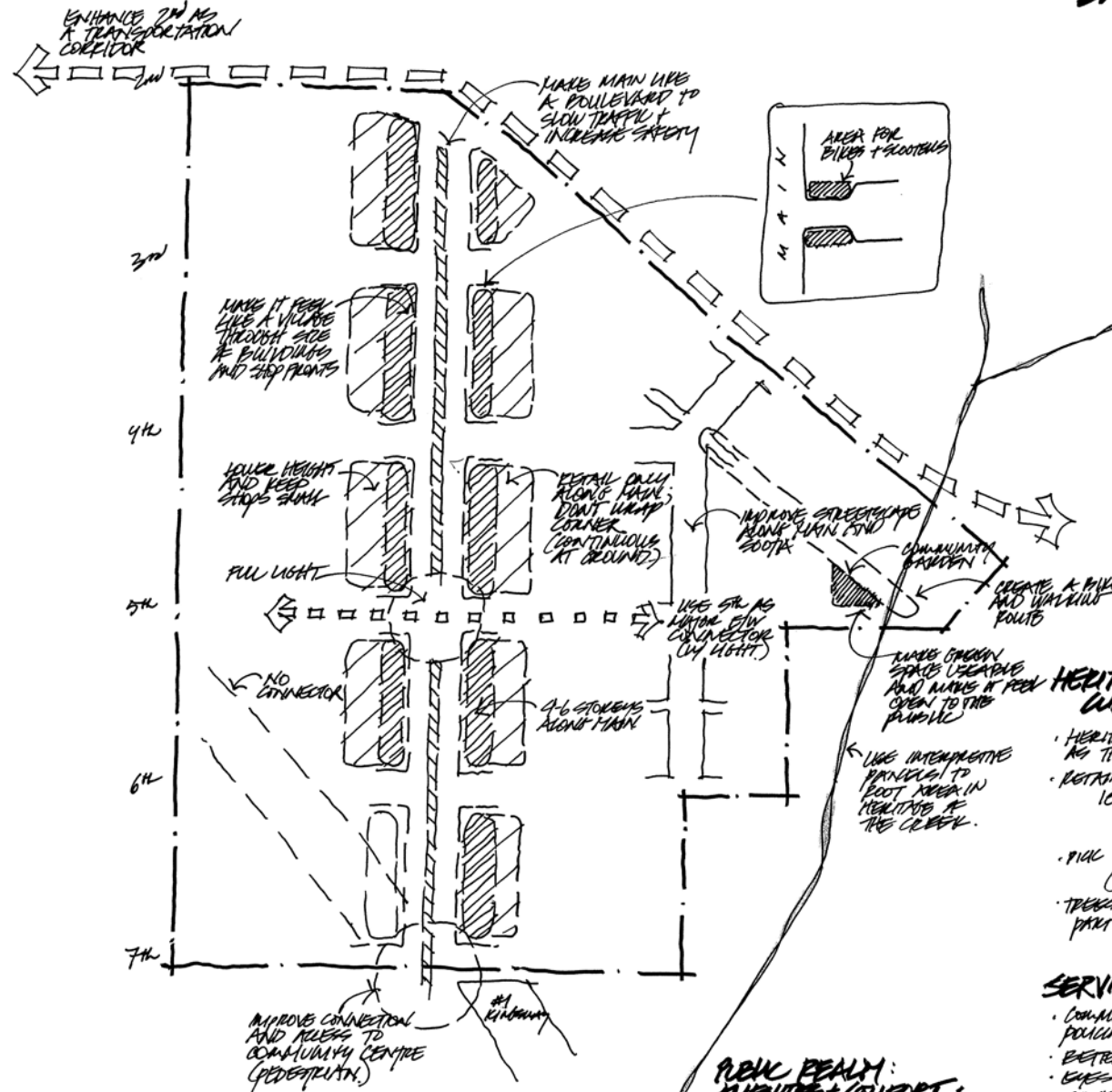
- NO CONNECTOR - PRIORITY SHOULD BE ON BUSES AND TRAM.

- MEDIAN ALONG MAIN.
- PARKING: MORE THAN ONE STRIP IS NEEDED, 2 CARS AND ALL UNDERGROUND.
