

APPENDIX I: MODELS AND CASES SUMMARY

The major models and options are variations on the theme of Value Adding Chains or Vertical Integration approaches. In the social enterprise variation, the different parts of the chain and integration are with community partners and regional goods and service inputs.

Value adding chains build collaborative management structures as well as information systems that enable each link in the chain to work together to better respond to customer demands and market changes.
