Parking Enforcement at the City of Vancouver Archives

To support improved customer service at the City of Vancouver Archives, effective Monday, April 14th, 2008, we will be making some procedural changes to the manner in which we manage the Archives' parking lot. To preserve the parking lot for visitors and users of the Archives, we have begun to monitor the parking lot's usage and have introduced some new procedures to better protect these privileges.

Patrons of the City of Vancouver Archives may request a parking pass from within the Archives facility. Vehicles parked without a pass are at risk of being towed.

We ask that you be considerate of the Archives' patrons and park in an alternative lot Monday to Friday, 8:30 am to 5:00 pm. The other lots available are:

- Gravel lot across the street from the Archives.
- The main lot located in front of the Vancouver Museum.
- The pay lot located at the end of Chestnut Street on either side of the Coast Guard Station.

Disregarding this notice may result in your vehicle being towed at its owner's expense.
