2. 4th Avenue Bike Lanes - NW Marine Drive to Highbury Street 5:45-6:15

Bicycle lanes on 4th Avenue have been installed from Drummond to Northwest Marine Drive as part of a repaving project. It is proposed to extend the 4th Avenue bike route to Highbury Street in the east with connection north to the Seaside Bikeway and to the south to the Off-Broadway Bikeway. This would involve lane striping only with possibly two traffic circles.
