EXTRACT FROM THE REGULAR COUNCIL MEETING ON NOVEMBER 1, 2005

B.1

1. Olympic Funding for Cycling Infrastructure (File 4209)

MOVED by Councillor Bass

SECONDED by Councillor Louis

WHEREAS

1. The City of Vancouver's bicycle infrastructure, according to the 1999 Vancouver Bicycle Plan, is significantly incomplete.
2. The City has a goal of cycle trips being 10% of the modal share by the year 2010 to coincide with the 2010 Winter Olympics.
3. The 2010 Winter Olympics are being promoted as "sustainable", and cycling is a sustainable mode of transportation;

THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED THAT Council direct staff to:

1. promote cycling as a means of transportation for the 2010 Olympics before, during, and after the games and
2. pursue opportunities for permanent cycling facilities and infrastructure for the City of Vancouver as an Olympic legacy.
