4. Mount Pleasant Plan 6:35-6:55

For the past three years, Planning and Engineering staff have been developing a new Community Plan for Mount Pleasant. Broadly, this Plan addresses land use and development within the community. Specific aspects of the Plan include safety, traffic, housing, parks, public places, environment, character, culture, and heritage. The Plan has been developed in consultation with community working groups as well as the general public. With regard to transportation, a strategy has been developed with an emphasis on sustainable modes. The issue of the Kingsway-Quebec connector has also been resolved -- rather than using a direct, diagonal link, traffic between Quebec Street and Main Street or Kingsway will continue to rely on all the Avenues from 1st to Broadway. The Plan also proposes to construct a cyclist-permeable median on E. 2nd Avenue at Ontario (in complement with left turn lanes on Quebec at 2nd) in order to restrict lefts to and from Ontario Street, among other proposals.

Staff from Planning and Engineering will present the plan and request input from the Committee.
