At-large or Wards Plebiscite

Volunteer Scrutineers

THE CITY OF Vancouver has opportunities for volunteer scrutineers in the upcoming plebiscite on Saturday, October 16, 2004. The vote will be on whether the City should adopt a ward system or retain the existing at-large system of electing Councillors. If you qualify as a Vancouver elector, you can apply to volunteer as a scrutineer for either the "yes" or "no" side of the question on the ballot.

Here is the exact question that will be on the ballot on October 16:

"Are you in favour of, or are you opposed to, abolishing the at-large system and electing members of City Council by a ward system, with boundaries as set out on the map on this ballot?"

- YES, I am in favour of adopting a ward system.
- NO, I am opposed to adopting a ward system."

You can apply to be a volunteer scrutineer from September 15 - 24, 2004. Applications are available from the Vancouver Election Office, 450 West Broadway, Vancouver, Monday to Friday, 8:30 am - 5 pm.

Applications must be returned to the Election Office by 5 pm, Friday, September 24, 2004. Applicants will then be advised of the voting place to which they have been assigned as a volunteer scrutineer.
