### ADVANCE REGISTRATION AND LIST OF ELECTORS



**Vancouver's Voters List is being prepared for the general local election to be held on Saturday, November 19, 2005.**

On November 19, 2005, Vancouver voters will elect a Mayor, 10 Councillors, seven Park Commissioners and nine School Trustees (voters on the University Endowment Lands will elect School Trustees only). Voters will also have a say on whether the City should borrow money for future infrastructure projects and programs.

If you were registered in Vancouver for the May 17, 2005 provincial election, you will automatically be on the Vancouver Municipal Voters List. However, if you wish to confirm that your name is on the list, or you have changed your name or address, contact the Election Office at 604.873.7681.

#### **ADVANCE REGISTRATION**

The City is offering advance registration until 5 pm, Tuesday, September 27, 2005. Registration forms are available on the City's website at [vancouver.ca/vote](http://vancouver.ca/vote); at the Election Office at 450 West Broadway, Vancouver; at City Hall; or at Vancouver community centres and libraries. Directions for completing and submitting the registration are on the back of the form.

#### **WHO IS ELIGIBLE TO REGISTER TO VOTE?**

You are eligible to register as an elector if you:

- will be 18 years of age or older on general voting day (November 19, 2005); and
- are a Canadian citizen; and
- have lived in B.C. for at least six months immediately before the day you register; and
- have lived in Vancouver for at least 30 days immediately before the day you register (OR have owned real property registered in your name in Vancouver for at least 30 days immediately before the day you register and live in another B.C. municipality\*); and
- are not disqualified by law from voting.

*\* Registrants to be non-resident property electors must phone the Election Office for further information about documents required.*

#### **VOTERS LIST**

Starting October 4, 2005, until the close of general voting on November 19, 2005, a copy of the Voters List will, upon signature, be available for public inspection at the City Clerk's Department in City Hall, 453 West 12th Avenue, and at the Election Office, 450 West Broadway, Vancouver from 8:30 am to 5 pm, Monday through Friday excluding statutory holidays.

#### **OBJECTION TO REGISTRATION OF AN ELECTOR**

Any objections to the registration of a person on the Voters List must be made in writing to the City Clerk by a person eligible to be registered as an elector, no later than 4 pm, October 14, 2005.

#### **OMITTING PERSONAL INFORMATION FROM THE VOTERS LIST**

Voters may request that their personal information be omitted from the Voters List to protect their privacy or security. Contact the Election Office for more details.
