NOTICE OF
NOMINATION FOR
2005 GENERAL
LOCAL ELECTION



STARTING OCTOBER 4, 2005 nominations will be received for the following offices in Vancouver:

- Mayor (one to be elected)
- Councillors (10 to be elected)
- Park Commissioners (seven to be elected)
- School Trustees (nine to be elected)

These offices are for a three-year term starting December 5, 2005.

The nomination period opens at 9 am, Tuesday, October 4, 2005 and closes at 4 pm, Friday, October 14, 2005.

Candidate Information packages, which include nomination papers, are available now at the Election Office, 450 West Broadway, Vancouver, or at the City Clerk's Department on the third floor of City Hall, 453 West 12th Avenue, Vancouver.

TO BE ELIGIBLE FOR NOMINATION CANDIDATES MUST:

- be 18 years of age or older on general voting day (November 19, 2005); and
- be a Canadian citizen; and
- have been a resident of B.C. for at least six months immediately before the day nomination papers are filed; and
- not be disqualified by any enactment from voting in an election in B.C. or from being nominated for, being elected to or holding office, or be otherwise disqualified by law.

Candidates wishing to file nomination documents should call the City Clerk's Department at 604.873.7276 to make an appointment for the October 4 - 14, 2005 nomination period.

During the nomination period, nomination documents may be delivered by hand, mail or courier to the City Clerk's Department, City Hall, Third Floor, 453 West 12th Avenue, Vancouver, B.C. V5Y 1V4, or faxed to 604.873.7419 (originals of faxes must be received by 5 pm, Friday, October 21, 2005). Candidates NOT delivering nomination papers by hand must take the documents to a lawyer, notary or Commissioner for Taking Affidavits for B.C. so that a solemn declaration may be administered.

A \$100 nomination deposit is required from each candidate in the form of cash, certified cheque or bank draft. Nomination deposits will be returned following proper filing of the candidate's Campaign Financing Disclosure Statements after the election.
