UEL Voter Information

Saturday, November 19, 2005, from 8 am to 8 pm, the City of Vancouver will hold a general local election. As the University Endowment Lands (UEL) are outside the City of Vancouver boundaries, UEL residents may vote **ONLY** for School Trustees.

You may vote for up to nine school trustees. The term for these elected officials is three years.

Why vote?

Elected officials make decisions that directly affect your everyday life. By voting, you have the power to influence those decisions.

**It's your school district...
vote on November 19.**

Who may vote?

To vote for Trustees for School District No. 39, you must:

- be 18 years of age or older on general voting day (November 19, 2005)
- be a Canadian citizen
- have lived in B.C. for at least six months immediately before voting day
- have lived in the UEL for at least 30 days immediately before voting day
- not be disqualified by law from voting.

You must meet ALL the above qualifications to be eligible to vote.

Landed immigrants who are not yet Canadian citizens are not permitted to vote.

Who is on the Voters List?

The City of Vancouver takes its Voters List from Elections B.C. If you were listed on the May 17, 2005 Provincial Voters List, you should be on the City Voters List. Where to vote

On Saturday, November 19, 2005, from 8 am to 8 pm, UEL residents may vote at:

- University Hill Secondary School, 2896 Acadia Road
- UBC – Student Union Building, 6138 Student Union Boulevard.

Registering to vote

If you are not on the Voters List, you complete a registration form at your voting place. You must provide two pieces of identification – one showing your signature and one showing your address.

Advance Voting

The City has advance voting opportunities November 5, 9, 15, and 16, 2005 from 8 am to 8 pm at the following locations:

- Vancouver City Hall, 453 West 12th Avenue
- Dunbar Community Centre, 4747 Dunbar Street
- Trout Lake Community Centre, 3350 Victoria Drive
- West End Community Centre, 870 Deman Street.

Special Voting Opportunities

If you have a disability, illness or injury that prevents you from going to the voting place, you may be eligible for a mail ballot. Call the Election Office at 604.873.7681 for details.
