Construction on Marine Drive Will Cause Delays

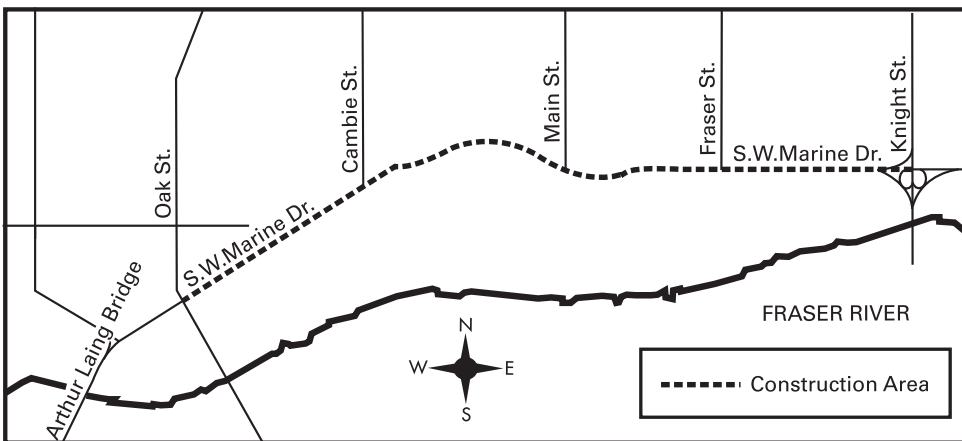
The City will start an extensive construction project on the Marine Drive corridor, from Knight to Oak Street (see map below), on April 12, 2000. The work involves replacing aging watermains and sewers, and repaving the uneven road surface.

The project will be done in phases and is expected to be completed by September 1.

The first phase of this project will be watermain construction on **Marine Drive from 70th Avenue to Main Street**. This work will disrupt traffic for four weeks. Construction work will take place on the south side of Marine Drive and will affect all vehicle traffic.

Sewer construction on Marine Drive, from St. George to Fraser Street, will start mid-June and be complete by the end of July. The sewer work will also extend north of Marine Drive along St. George's Street.

The City will try to reduce disruption to traffic by minimizing the size of the construction area. However, residents and commuters should expect delays and consider alternate routes to avoid the construction area.
