## Seismic Upgrading of Burrard Bridge May Cause Delays

City crews working on the Burrard Street Bridge this weekend and next weekend will reduce traffic from six lanes to four lanes.

Crews will replace an expansion joint near the north end of the bridge, on:

**Saturday, September 16 7 a.m. - 5 p.m.**

**Sunday, September 17 8 a.m. - 5 p.m.**

**Saturday, September 23 7 a.m. - 5 p.m.**

This work is the first phase of a seismic upgrade program for the north spans of Burrard Bridge. Once these three days of work are complete, the remaining seismic work will occur below the road deck and will not impact traffic.

Warning signs directing motorists to Granville Bridge will be up, and Police will be on the scene to direct traffic. Sidewalks will remain open, so pedestrians and cyclists should not be affected. Residents and commuters are encouraged to use alternate routes, or travel outside construction hours.
