Priorities

Exchange information with the lesbian, gay, bisexual, transgender, two-spirit and queer communities and the general public about relevant programs and issues of interest.

Engage in outreach to the LGBTQ2S+ communities to disseminate information and encourage participation.

Work co-operatively with other civic agencies whose activities affect LGBTQ2+ communities, including initiating and developing relevant projects.

Provide input to Council and staff about issues of concern, including matter s that require action by the City.

Act as a resource for staff doing public involvement processes.

Work with city staff to ensure that City facilities and events are accessible for people who identify as outside the gender binary.

Accomplishments

Built ongoing relationships and collaboration with the VPD including the introduction of a VPD Liaison to the Committee.



Collaborated with other city committees and community to explore accessible housing options for trans and gender variant youth.

Consulted with City staff around LGBTQ2S+ access to City of Vancouver employment and services.

Future Goals

Make policy recommendations to the City around reparative therapy.

Raise community awareness and accessibility for LGBTQ2S+ older adults.

Work with community and key stakeholder s to establish the second phase of the Davie Street public space improvement in creating a outdoor museum for the LGBTQ2S+

community.
