Leadership, Gender Wage Gap, Violence Against Women and Young Women.

Hosted a Women's History Month public event at City Hall Celebrating Women in Sport. Co-wrote and were presented the 2016
International Women's Day Proclamation at City Hall.

Top 3 Future Goals

Work with City Staff to update the City of Vancouver's Gender Equality Strategy.

Finalize Best Practices documents for each sub-committee and share publicly.

Increase awareness and accessibility of WAC and other COV Advisory
Committees, and encourage diverse involvement from all women in Vancouver.
