## 2. LGBTQ2+ Advisory Committee

Drew Dennis, Co-Chair, LGBTQ2+ Advisory Committee, provided an overview of the LGBTQ2+ Advisory Committee's initiatives, and highlighted the Park Board's approval of gender neutral signs, the Vancouver School Board's approval of a transgender policy, the revitalization of Davie Village, and priority actions toward providing greater inclusivity.

Drew Dennis responded to questions from the group.

## 3. Engaged City Task Force Work

Tracy Vaughan, Corporate Communications, provided a presentation on the "Mayor's Engaged City Task Force Final Report", which outlines a vision for an engaged City, priority actions, recommended ideas for community action and tools to measure progress.

The discussion centered on the creation of more public, community and cultural spaces, and ideas on building a social and engaged community.
