## 1. CCAC Capacity Building Corner - Speaker re: Islamophobia

The Committee discussed initiatives for capacity building, which included reaching out to other advisory committees to discuss partnership opportunities, and utilizing social and news media to target key messages. The Committee also reviewed its poster content for the upcoming Council of Councils meeting on October 12, and will include their recent statement release and spaces project update in their presentation.

It was noted there will be a workshop planned to educate on the history of Islam and gain a better understanding of Muslim and Jewish communities in Vancouver. Rajpal Kohli, Staff Liaison, noted there is a workshop on "Impacts of Residential Schools and Colonization" on October 24, and to let her know if interested in attending. In addition, the Chair mentioned he will be following up with City staff on setting up a social media training session for Committee members.

## 2. Spaces Project

The Spaces subcommittee provided an update on the project, and noted the survey was sent out to 60 cultural community groups, ranging from small ethno-cultural groups seeking space to more established cultural community groups with space and resources to provide. The Committee is in the process of following up with each of these groups and preparing for a collaborative forum.

### 3. Special Meeting - Recap of Motion/ Press Release

The Committee reviewed their recent release of a statement condemning the anti-immigrant, anti-Semitic, and Islamophobic protests, violence and vitriol; and expressed their motivation to focus on community-building efforts and initiatives, such as the "Voices of Vancouver" project.

## 4. Voices of Vancouver - Brainstorming

The Committee brainstormed ideas on implementing the "Voices of Vancouver" project, which seeks to attain three goals: Empower, Educate and Hear/Share voices.
