b) Davie Village Revitalization

Ron Stipp provided a verbal update on progress with the consultation process, noting stakeholders have expressed support for revitalization. Once the consultation process is completed, Mr. Stipp will bring an interim report before the Committee for consideration.

In discussion, suggestions included the following:

- Davie Street needs to be interactive;
- there needs to be more vibrancy;
- look at other cities such as Manchester, and London for ideas; and
- consider festivals that could include a "queer twist" as opposed to just having a presence at "queer festivals".

c) Safe, Healthy and Engaged Communities

Mike Soron and Patrick Tham provided a verbal update on progress, noting Councillor Reimer, at a recent meeting, encouraged members to be event-focussed. Details of the next open meeting on January 20, 2013, will be communicated to members shortly.
