1. Presentation of Mayor's Task Force on City Engagement

Councillor Andrea Reimer provided an update on the Mayor's Engaged City Task Force, summarized the "Quick Start" recommendations and reviewed next steps.

In discussion, the Committee agreed to the following:

- invite task force members Sam Chen and Dennis Chan to the next Engagement Working Group meeting to review the "Quick Start" recommendations with members through the lens of multiculturalism; and

Councillor Reimer asked members to contact her should they identify specific communities to reach out to in implementing the "Quick Start" recommendations. She also noted that the Council of Council's meeting will be scheduled in November and that this subject will be included on the agenda.

Co-Chair Yan agreed to follow-up with the Staff Liaison on inviting the Vancouver Foundation to the December meeting to present their report "Connections and Engagement".

2. Community Forum Working Group: Report and Discussion of Future Plan

The Committee discussed next steps and it was agreed that Nellie Cheng call a working group meeting for late October in order to draft recommendations for the Committee's consideration at the December meeting.

- Hastings Park/PNE governance to continue under the PNE Board;
- Walk for Reconciliation;
- Stanley Park's 125th Anniversary celebrations; and
- a donation of 100 hydrangeas to plant around the city.

7. New Business

a) Komagata Maru

Manjot Bains noted the 100th Anniversary of the Komagata Maru in 2014, and reviewed events.

In response to questions, Ms. Bain agreed to follow-up with the Staff Liaison on City participation.

b) Nike Statue

Co-Chair Douzenis advised that staff are looking at a date in November for the unveiling of the Goddess Nike Statue at Cordova and Thurlow Streets, noting the Hellenic community is very proud of this long awaited event.
