# 1. Idea of Sanctuary City - Report and Discussion

Mui Chung Yan provided a report back on the Sanctuary City Forum held on May 9, 2014, hosted by the Mayor's Working Group on Immigration (MWGI).

Discussion ensued regarding how people without legal or landed status access essential services, and whether the City and/or the Committee has a role in the matter.

Mr. Yan encouraged members to provide suggestions or concerns to him to bring forward to the MWGI, and noted he will provide further updates from the Working Group on the discussion.

### 2. Resolutions to Council

## Support for Multicultural and Welcoming Initiatives at the City of Vancouver

The Committee reviewed their work over the term and the various ideas and feedback received from public dialogues and community groups, and recommended that the following motion be presented to Council for their consideration and approval.

WHEREAS the City of Vancouver, as a signatory to the Coalition of Municipalities Against Racial Discrimination, has undertaken initiatives in creating inclusive and welcoming communities, and has hosted intercultural dialogues and forums to engage residents and groups;

THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED THAT the Multicultural Advisory Committee recommends that the City budget include a line item which can support activities related to engaging both newcomers and established residents, to facilitate intercultural education and dialogue, and to empower minority groups.

## 3. Follow-up on the Mayor's Engaged City Task Force

The Staff Liaison provided an update on the Mayor's Engaged City Task Force and upcoming activities, including a booklet being prepared that promotes block parties and the Pop-up City Hall pilot project, and requested suggestions from the committee on how best to engage newcomer residents in those activities.

The committee suggested signage in different languages (and through translation) be considered for outreach activities, and presence at large civic events would help engage new residents.

He also noted the Park Board received for information a report entitled "Building a Path to Parks and Recreation for All", prepared by the Trans and Gender-Variant Inclusion Working Group, and approved a motion providing direction on the matter to staff.
