# 1. Offsite - Public Art Space at Shangri-La Hotel

Diana Freundl, Curator, Vancouver Art Gallery, presented previous public art exhibitions at the Vancouver Art Gallery and described the upcoming installation by Shanghai and Beijing-based artist collective "Madeln Company" (*April 26 - September 29, 2013*). Ms. Freundl, along with Bryan Newson, Staff Liaison, responded to questions.

### 2. Restructure Public Art Funding

Richard Newirth, Managing Director, Cultural Services, and Bryan Newson, Staff Liaison, presented proposed recommendations on public art program funding, based on Council's Motion as adopted on January 30, 2013 (*Restructuring Public Art Program Funding*). Staff's presentation included a review of changes to the private sector requirements, overall site planning, City funding and next steps.

In discussion, points raised included the following:

- clarification on the relationship between the public art requirement and community amenity contributions, given that developers who provide public art must often also provide affordable housing, park space, daycare space, and public realm improvements;
- request that staff provide a map/list of public artworks that clearly distinguishes
  publicly funded artworks from works funded by private development and also shows all
  artwork on public lands regardless of funding source;
- suggestions on various ways of increasing the public art profile in the City's larger public realm discussion, to ensure Council and management staff are aware that Vancouver artists are recognized internationally, and that public art has a major role to play in the public realm and contemporary art ambitions of the city.

Staff agreed to provide a list of public art throughout the city.

### 3. Gift and Long-term Loan Policies

Karen Henry, Planner, Public Art Program, reviewed draft Guidelines for Short and Long-Term Loans of Artwork in Public Spaces *(on file)* and, along with jil Weaving, Park Board Liaison, responded to questions.
