The City of Vancouver's Neighbourhood Emergency Preparedness Program (NEPP) is recruiting volunteer trainers for the NEPP program.

The NEPP program teaches the citizens of Vancouver to be prepared for emergencies or disasters. The NEPP sessions are presented at community centres and the class sizes range from 8 - 20 people. We also provide presentations for groups on a request basis.

Being a NEPP trainer provides you with opportunity to gain confidence in public speaking, the opportunity to work with people and provides you with information on personal and family preparedness.
