



REQUEST FOR APPLICATIONS: EXPANDED STREET FOOD OPTIONS ON CITY PROPERTY  
PILOT PROGRAM  
(JULY 2010 - APRIL 30, 2011)

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The City of Vancouver seeks applications for new and existing street food vendors to participate in a pilot program to increase street food options in Vancouver. The goals of the program are to help provide more diverse culinary options on Vancouver streets, promote small business growth, increase the availability of healthy and local food choices, and increase activity in the public realm. The duration of the pilot program is from July 2010 to April 30, 2011. The pilot program is part of a long-term plan to expand street food options in Vancouver on City property and private property. This phase of the program entails City property only (sidewalks and curbside locations). Future phases of the program may entail private property (e.g. parking lots).

**Applications will be accepted from June 21 until 4:00 PM on June 30, 2010.**

Up to 17 new locations on City property are available through the pilot program (see Attachment A for complete listing and conditions). The new locations will be filled through a lottery process. To be eligible to apply, the following conditions must be met:

- Applicants must be prepared to begin operations no later than July 31, 2010.
- Applicants should offer menu items other than hot dogs and pre-packaged, non-perishable food like soft drinks, chips, candy bars, granola and nuts.
- Applicants should offer nutritional options as part of their menu.
- Applicants should have a plan to reduce the environmental impact of their operation (i.e. waste management and / or diversion).
