Ed just visited Langara to do a follow up inspection visit. Things for the most part looked good.

There are two outstanding items on the Fire Inspection still requiring follow up:

- 1. "K" class fire extinguisher in kitchen requires further testing
- 2. The Fire Alarm system at stage 2 needs more work

Currently, we are still not in compliance with both these items, and Ed will be calling you to discuss resolution of the above.
