Re: Request for Access to Records under the Freedom of Information and Protection of Privacy Act (the "Act")

I am responding to your request of March 13, 2016 for:

- 1. Records from 311 related to adverse conditions, potholes or maintenance required on the Oak Street Bridge on January 27, 2016;
- 2. Communications between the City and other parties such as the BC Ministry of Transportation and subcontractors regarding these conditions from January 26 to January 28, 2016.

All responsive records are attached for part 1 of your request. The 311 Contact Centre does not have responsive records relating to part 2. Please note the City is responsible for the road leading to the bridge deck for Burrard and Georgia bridges only; whereas, the Ministry of Transportation is responsible for the bridge deck.
