Re: Request for Access to Records under the Freedom of Information and Protection of Privacy Act (the "Act")

I am writing in response to your request received on May 24, 2016 for:

The following information from April 29 to June 1, 2016:

- All by-law officer enforcement costs associated with regulating marijuana dispensaries in the City of Vancouver;
- 2. How many by-law officers are engaging in enforcement?
- 3. How many hours have they worked and at what pay rate?

The following are responses from the Manager of Property Use and Inspections:

- There were overtime hours scheduled for the first day of enforcement on Saturday, April 30, 2016. There were four Property Use Inspectors working overtime costing \$3200.
- 2. All 24 Property Use Inspectors are enforcing as needed within their regular enforcement day.
- 3. We are not tracking this as the enforcement is embedded within their regular day and their regular duties.

Under section 52 of the Act you may ask the Information & Privacy Commissioner to review any matter related to the City's response to your request. The Act allows you 30 business days from the date you receive this notice to request a review by writing to: Office of the Information & Privacy Commissioner, info@oipc.bc.ca or by phoning 250-387-5629.

If you request a review, please provide the Commissioner's office with: 1) the request number assigned to your request (04-1000-20-2016-189); 2) a copy of this letter; 3) a copy of your original request for information sent to the City of Vancouver; and 4) detailed reasons or grounds on which you are seeking the review.
