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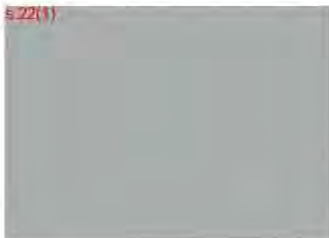

Canada recognized Chinatown as a National Historic Site and yet significant changes are happening to alter the fabric of the community. There must be a balance between the necessary updating and development in the city and respect for its historic past, people and architecture. Dominating tall new structures like the Beedie Group's proposed project threaten to overshadow the neighbourhood and as presented are completely out of step with respecting the cultural heritage of Chinatown.
