Re: Request for Access to Records under the Freedom of Information and Protection of Privacy Act (the "Act")

I am responding to your request of November 18, 2016 for:

Any documents that include estimates of the increase in revenue that will come from the switch to a data-driven scheme to set metered parking rates (including the immediate rounding up of meter rates) from January 1, 2016 to November 17, 2016.

We have completed the search for responsive records for this request and no responsive records have been located. I have been advised by the General Manager of Engineering and the Branch Manager of Parking Management that they are currently planning an approach that will track specific metrics which will then be utilized to produce precise estimates. This plan to date is currently in discussion only. I am recommending that you resubmit your request in six months.

Under section 52 of the Act you may ask the Information & Privacy Commissioner to review any matter related to the City's response to your request. The Act allows you 30 business days from the date you receive this notice to request a review by writing to: Office of the Information & Privacy Commissioner, info@oipc,bc.ca or by phoning 250-387-5629.

If you request a review, please provide the Commissioner's office with: 1) the request number assigned to your request (#04-1000-20-2016-433); 2) a copy of this letter; 3) a copy of your original request for information sent to the City of Vancouver; and 4) detailed reasons or grounds on which you are seeking the review.
