Re: Request for Access to Records under the Freedom of Information and Protection of Privacy Act (the "Act")

I am responding to your request of November 29, 2016 for:

- A. Copies of all versions of all scripts and videos featuring Mayor Gregor Robertson that were recorded on the same day as the YouTube video titled "Kinder Morgan Decision" (which was published Nov. 29);
- B. All records about the contracting and payment of personnel for camera operation, lighting, sound, editing and production related to the above.

All responsive records are attached, relating to Part A of your request. For Part B of your request, please note that there were no contractors and no costs associated with the script or video and that the video was taken via phone by staff.

Under section 52 of the Act you may ask the Information & Privacy Commissioner to review any matter related to the City's response to your request. If you request a review, please provide the Commissioner's office with: 1) the request number assigned to your request (#04-1000-20-2016-447); 2) a copy of this letter; 3) a copy of your original request for information sent to the City of Vancouver; and 4) detailed reasons or grounds on which you are seeking the review.
