SUBJECT: SW Marine Drive Improvements -Construction and Roadway Closure

Starting May 8th, City construction crews will begin Phase II of the SW Marine Drive Project involving sewer upgrades, road rehabilitation and multi-modal transportation improvements to ensure comfort and safety for people of all ages and abilities, as outlined in the Council Report from December 1, 2015, RTS 11138.

Similar to the requirements of the Phase I work completed in 2016, the nature of the work for Phase II requires that the road be closed between Granville Street in the east and Camosun Street in the west to ensure that the work can be completed safely (refer to Fig. 1). The closure points will be supported by VPD Traffic Authority and were selected to ensure through traffic is redirected to other arterial streets which minimises impacts, such as shortcutting and speeding, on residential streets in the area. Local access will be maintained at all times, with vehicle decals provided to local residents to ensure ease of access. The project will be completed and the road re-opened by Labour Day September 4th 2017.

In the lead up to construction, staff have met with key stakeholders, held public open houses and installed Changeable Message Boards and other construction advisory signs at strategic locations throughout the City to communicate closure locations and duration.
