Good afternoon Mayor and Councillors,

The injunction application filed by Lu'ma Native Housing Society in respect of the encampment at 950 Main St was heard in Court today. The judge adjourned the hearing until Monday; however, he gave a very strong indication that he will grant an injunction to Lu'ma on Monday.

Lu'ma needs the site empty by next Friday so that they can commence construction work. The campers, represented by Maria Wallstam, indicated that they will leave peacefully and asked for some extra time as it was cheque day today.

Outreach staff are visiting the site twice a day to prepare a list of all who need shelter and are working with BC Housing to ensure that shelter spots are made available as early as Monday or Tuesday.

We will provide a further update once we have the Court's ruling on Monday. In the interim, please let me know if you have any questions.
