Re: Request for Access to Records under the Freedom of Information and Protection of Privacy Act (the "Act")

I am responding to your request of April 10, 2017 for:

- Records showing the time that the City of Vancouver installed "No Parking, Passenger Zone" signs on March 31, 2017 at the 100 block of Columbia St. South/West side; and
- Records indicating whether City workers recorded license plate numbers belonging to vehicles already parked at that location between 17:45 and 24:00.

We have completed the search for responsive records for this request and no responsive records have been located.

- The Traffic and Electrical Operations Branch checked their systems for any work on 0-100 Columbia, 0-199 Alexander and 0-199 Powell St, and can find no indication that the City installed any signs on 100 Columbia on March 31, 2017, or for one week on either side.
- Timesheets from March 31, 2017 were reviewed which found no indication of any work done at the requested location.
- The Streetview system shows that there is a no parking passenger zone sign on the West side of 100 Columbia which is a permanent sign, and was not recently installed or repaired. The City did install signs on 200 Columbia on March 31, 2017, but they were for filming, not a passenger zone.
- As there was no work done, at the 100 block of Columbia St. South/West side, there are no records to indicate whether City workers recorded license plate numbers already parked at that location between 17:45 and 24:00.

Under section 52 of the Act you may ask the Information & Privacy Commissioner to review any matter related to the City's response to your request. The Act allows you 30 business days

from the date you receive this notice to request a review by writing to: Office of the Information & Privacy Commissioner, <u>info@oipc.bc.ca</u> or by phoning 250-387-5629.

If you request a review, please provide the Commissioner's office with: 1) the request number assigned to your request (#04-1000-20-2017-152); 2) a copy of this letter; 3) a copy of your original request for information sent to the City of Vancouver; and 4) detailed reasons or grounds on which you are seeking the review.
