Re: Request for Access to Records under the Freedom of Information and Protection of Privacy Act (the "Act")

I am responding to your request of April 28, 2017 for:

From January 1, 2011 to April 28, 2016, the amount paid by the City for each year for:

- 1) fleet insurance to ICBC (after discount/surcharge);
- 2) the insurance discount/surcharge;
- 3) the base amount charged (so the amount the municipality would have been charged with no discount/surcharge); and
- 4) the number of claims and the cost amount of these claims.

All responsive records are attached.

Under section 52 of the Act you may ask the Information & Privacy Commissioner to review any matter related to the City's response to your request. If you request a review, please provide the Commissioner's office with: 1) the request number assigned to your request (#04-1000-20-2017-178); 2) a copy of this letter; 3) a copy of your original request for information sent to the City of Vancouver; and 4) detailed reasons or grounds on which you are seeking the review.
