RE: Request for Access to Records under the Freedom of Information and Protection of Privacy Act (the "Act")

I am responding to your request dated July 14, 2017 under the *Freedom of Information and Protection of Privacy Act* for:

1. Accident complaints involving bicycles, scooters and motorcycles regarding the trolley tracks in Granville Island (Anderson and Cartwright intersection) from January 1, 2013 to July 7, 2017;
2. Legal claims about bicycles, scooters and motorcycles regarding accidents and the trolley tracks in Granville Island (Anderson and Cartwright intersection) from January 1, 2013 to July 7, 2017; and
3. Memorandums, correspondence, statistics and internal staff reports regarding the Granville Island trolley tracks related to safety concerns/issues.

The Canadian Mortgage and Housing Corporation is a separate public body under the Act; therefore, we are transferring your request to the FOI Office at the CMHC pursuant to section 11 of the Act.

Please note: all of Granville Island (and the specific intersection of Andersen and Cartwright) are not within the City's jurisdiction.
