Re: Request for Access to Records under the Freedom of Information and Protection of Privacy Act (the "Act")

I am responding to your request of September 21, 2017 for:

Any and all permits and licenses issued by the City of Vancouver to allow the filming of "A Dog's Way Home", a movie which is reportedly scheduled to be filming in Vancouver from October 16, 2017 to December 15, 2017. Request specifically includes, but is not limited to, all film activity permits issued to the following:

- Production company, Pariah Entertainment Group;
- 2. Movie producer, Gavin Polone:
- 3. Movie director, Charles Martin; and
- 4. Movie studio, Sony.

The Film and Special Events Department has advised us the filming has not yet started so no permits have been issued. In order to ensure we can meet the required statutory deadlines, please re-submit your request for the above records in 60 days.

Under section 52 of the Act you may ask the Information & Privacy Commissioner to review any matter related to the City's response to your request. If you request a review, please provide the Commissioner's office with: 1) the request number assigned to your request (#04-1000-20-2017-354); 2) a copy of this letter; 3) a copy of your original request for information sent to the City of Vancouver; and 4) detailed reasons or grounds on which you are seeking the review.
