Re: Request for Access to Records under the Freedom of Information and Protection of Privacy Act (the "Act")

I am responding to your request of December 13, 2017 for:

- Any and all documentation, reports, analysis, scoring or other information related to the evaluation, scoring and ranking of all vendors proposal responses submitted in response to the RFP, including each individual evaluation team member's scoring sheets, notes and other information; and
- 3. Any contract associated with the RFP.

(b) The Proponent now irrevocably waives all rights it may have by statute, at law or in equity, to obtain any records produced or kept by the City in evaluating its Proposal (and any other submissions) and now agrees that under no circumstances will it make any application to the City or any court for disclosure of any records pertaining to the receipt, evaluation or selection of its Proposal (or any other submissions) including, without limitation, records relating only to the Proponent.

This clause precludes using the Freedom of Information and Protection of Privacy legislation to request records covered under clause 8.3 of the standard RFP submission.
