Re: Request for Access to Records under the Freedom of Information and Protection of Privacy Act (the "Act")

I am responding to your request of January 23, 2018 for:

- 1. Total number of Residential Parking Permits issued for the Industrial Zone bounded by Cambie, Main, Broadway and 2nd Avenue;
- 2. Total number of Visitor and Temporary residential parking permits issued for the Industrial Zone bounded by Cambie, Main, Broadway and 2nd Avenue; and
- 3. Total number of residential parking places available within these boundaries.

Date Range: January 1, 2017 to December 31, 2017

Please see the following information:

For part one of your request, the total number of Residential Parking Permits issued for the Industrial Zone bounded by Cambie, Main, Broadway and 2nd Avenue is 130.

For part two of your request, the total number of Visitor and Temporary residential parking permits issued for the Industrial Zone bounded by Cambie, Main, Broadway and 2nd Avenue is seven.

For part three of your request, the total number of residential parking places available within these boundaries is estimated at 60-65 residential parking spaces in the Industrial permit zone.

Please note: these values do not represent the total number of active permits; they include permits that have been issued and then closed. The total number of active permits at this time (March 22, 2018) is 109 Residential Parking Permits (Annual Residential Parking Permits).

Under section 52 of the Act you may ask the Information & Privacy Commissioner to review any matter related to the City's response to your request. The Act allows you 30 business days from the date you receive this notice to request a review by writing to: Office of the
