Re: Request for Access to Records under the Freedom of Information and Protection of Privacy Act (the "Act")

I am responding to your request of February 14, 2018 for:

At the T intersection of East 30th Avenue and Prince Albert Street, where the sidewalks on East 30th extend eastwards through the sidewalk on the east side of Prince Albert Street, in front of 4586 Prince Albert Street. Request is for the following information:

- 1. Number of parking tickets that have been issued for blocking the sidewalk connections; and
- 2. Number of vehicles that have been ticketed and towed for blocking the sidewalk connections.

Date Range: January 1, 2016 to February 14, 2018

Parking Operations and Enforcement Branch confirmed that eight parking tickets were issued at this site during the dates specified, and that five of those tickets were marked to be towed. However, the actual number of vehicles towed may be lower as vehicles can leave before Busters Towing arrives.

Under section 52 of the Act you may ask the Information & Privacy Commissioner to review any matter related to the City's response to your request. The Act allows you 30 business days from the date you receive this notice to request a review by writing to: Office of the Information & Privacy Commissioner, <u>info@oipc.bc.ca</u> or by phoning 250-387-5629.

If you request a review, please provide the Commissioner's office with: 1) the request number assigned to your request (#04-1000-20-2018-098); 2) a copy of this letter; 3) a copy of your original request for information sent to the City of Vancouver; and 4) detailed reasons or grounds on which you are seeking the review.
