Reiderman Residence 7430 and 7460 Heather Street (w 59th Ave and Heather St)

- Two temporary modular housing buildings are being constructed at 7430 and 7460 Heather Street. Building one is nearing completion; it is estimated to open around mid-February. Building two is estimated to be completed around late-February.
- BC Housing owns the buildings, and has secured Community Builders Group, a non-profit housing operator, to manage and operate the buildings.

- A Community Advisory Committee (CAC) of approximately 20 members is being established to:
 - Build and maintain positive relationships amongst the community, the building operators and the program partners
 - Facilitate information sharing and dialogue
 - o Identify and resolve any issues, opportunities and concerns related to building operations
- The CAC includes community members, Parent Advisory Council members, a local school Principal, representatives from BC Housing, Community Builders Group, Vancouver Coastal Health, the Pearson Dogwood Centre, the Vancouver Police Department, and people representing local community and business interests.

- The CAC will have its first meeting before the occupancy permit is issued for building one. CAC members have been confirmed and invited to the first meeting.

- The Reiderman Residence name was chosen in honour of a long-time Community Builders Group staff member, Jennie Reiderman. Jennie was a tireless and dedicated advocate who worked with elderly, sick and vulnerable community members. She lost her battle with cancer in late 2017.
